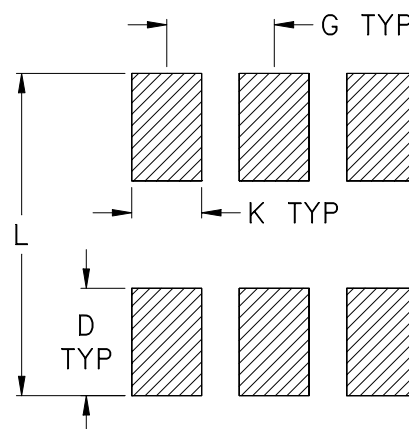
Typical Performance Curves

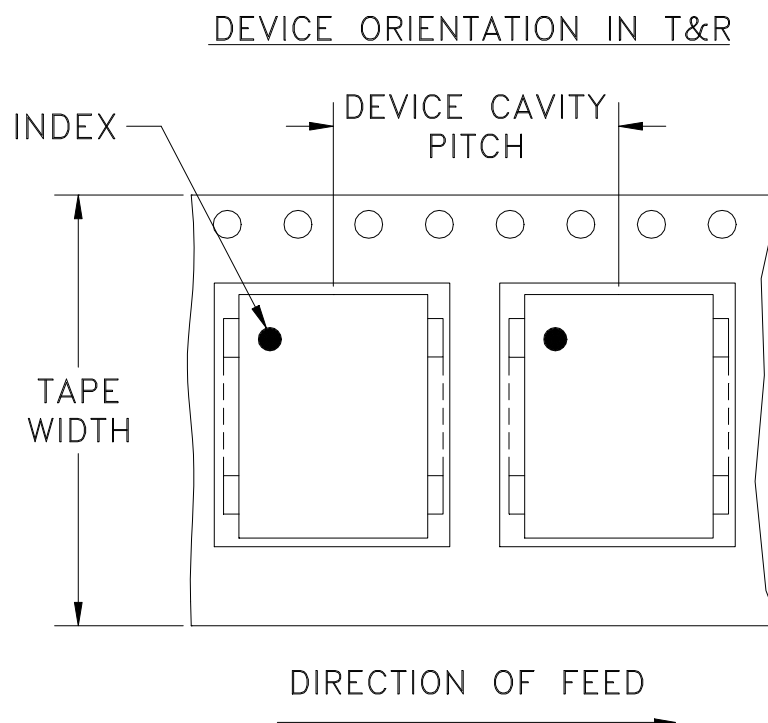
