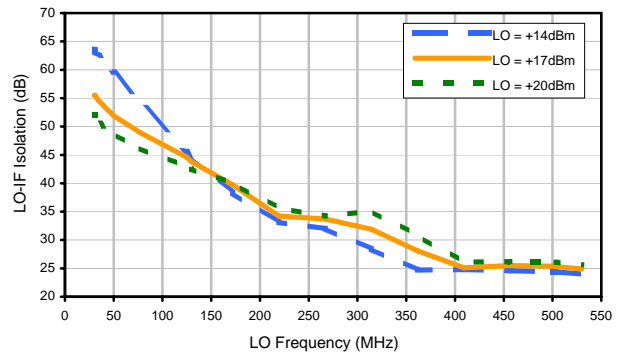

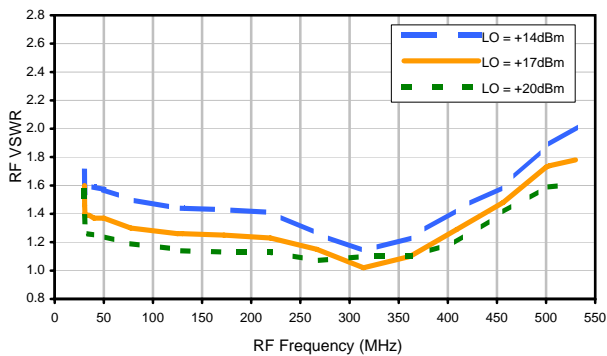
LO-RF Isolation



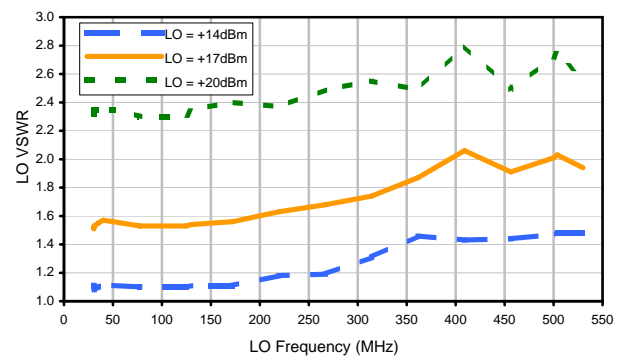

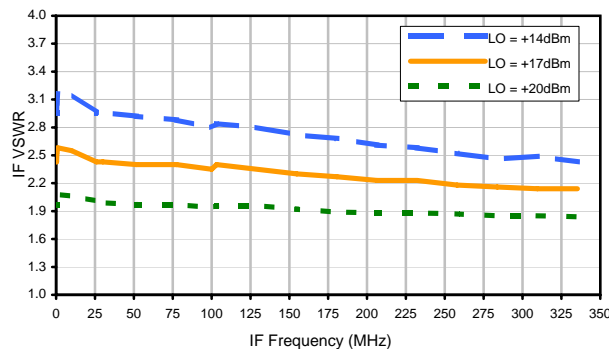
