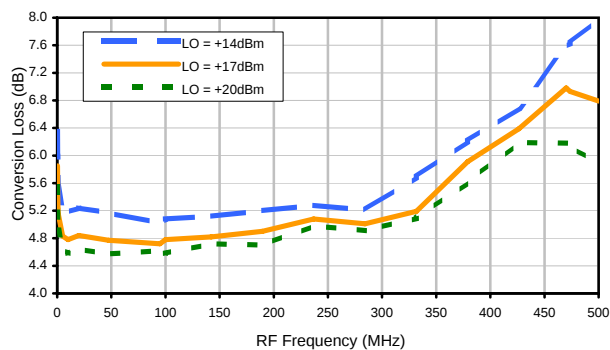

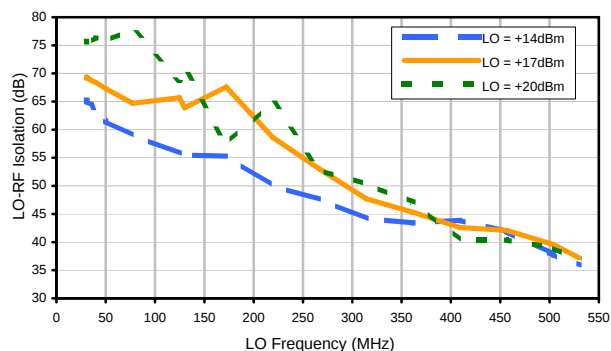

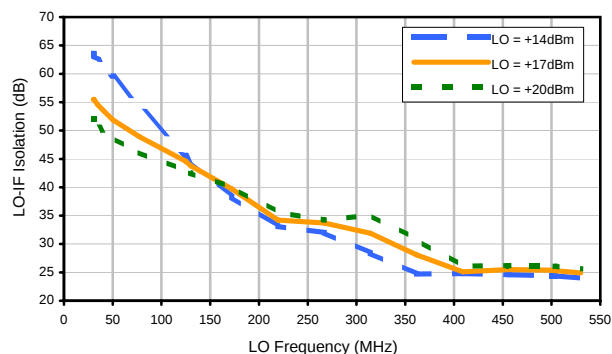
Conversion Loss



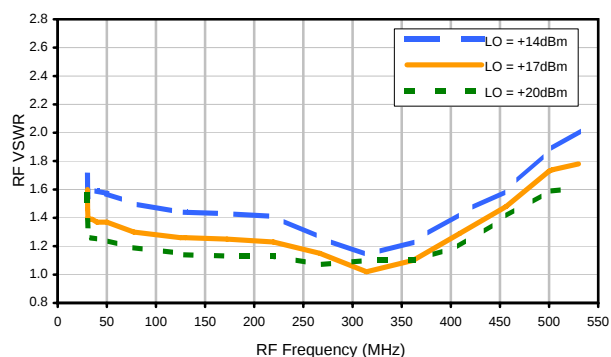
LO-RF Isolation



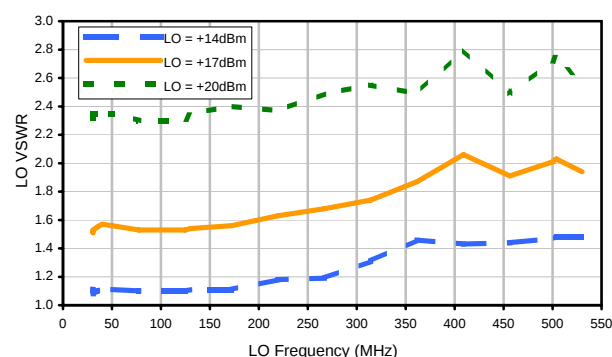
LO-IF Isolation



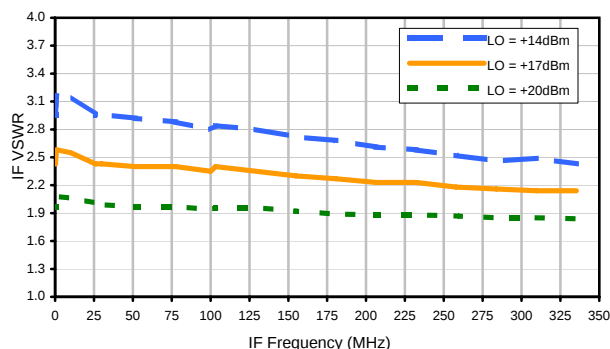

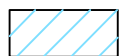

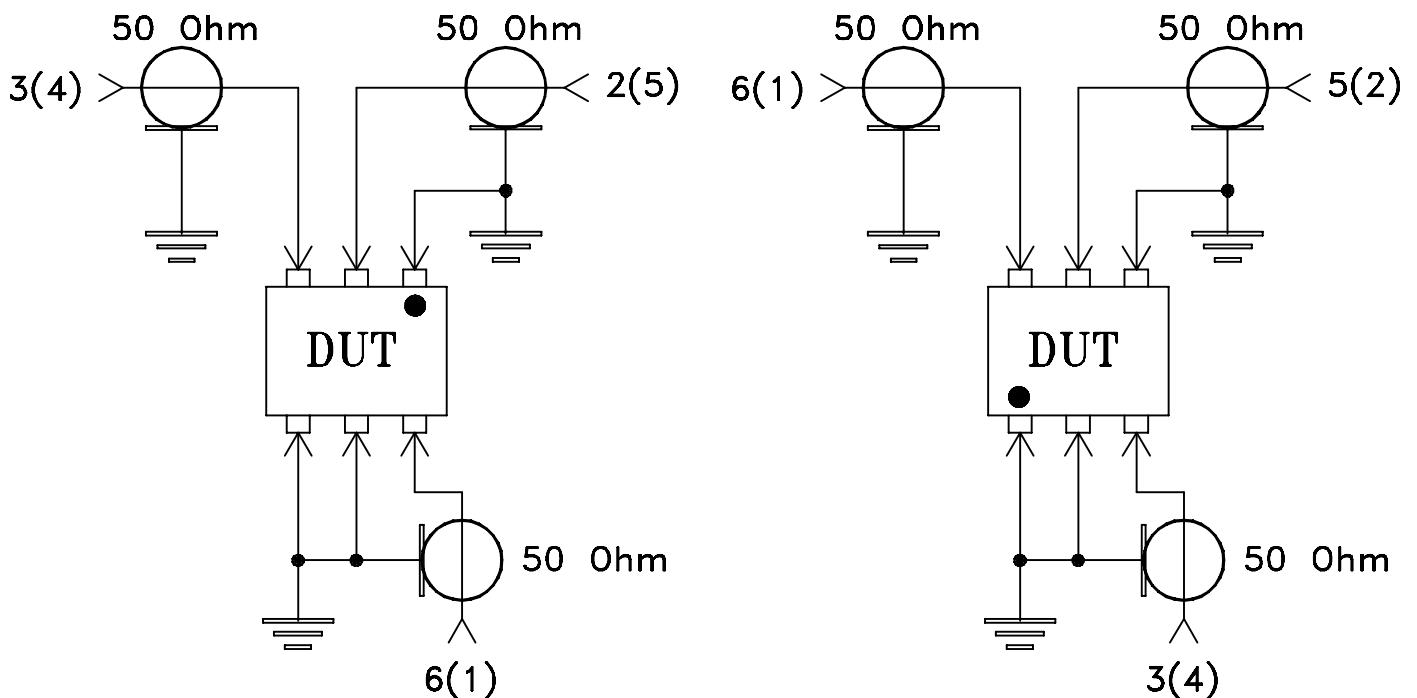
