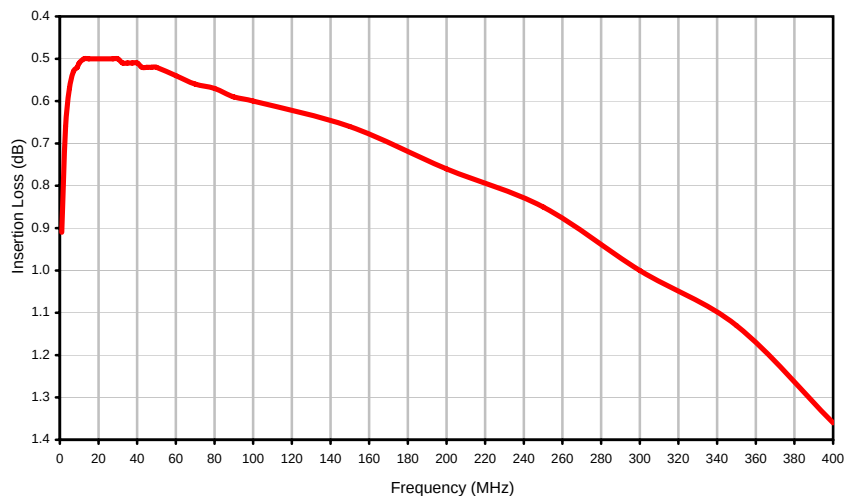

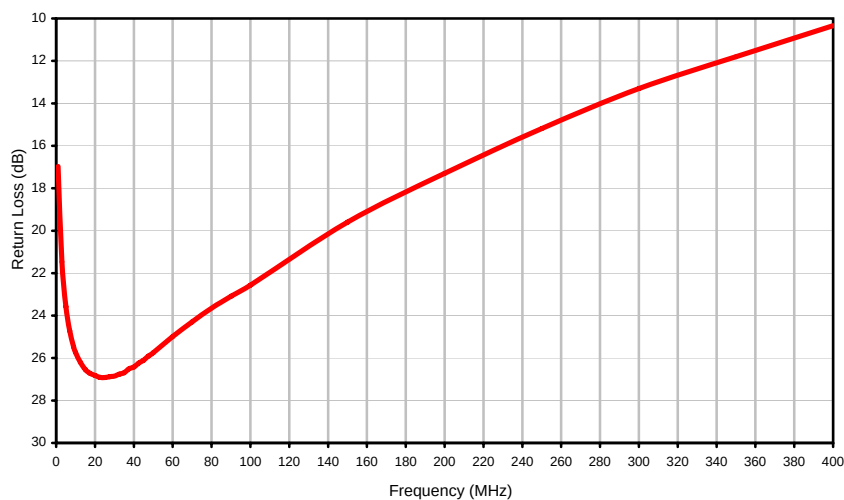

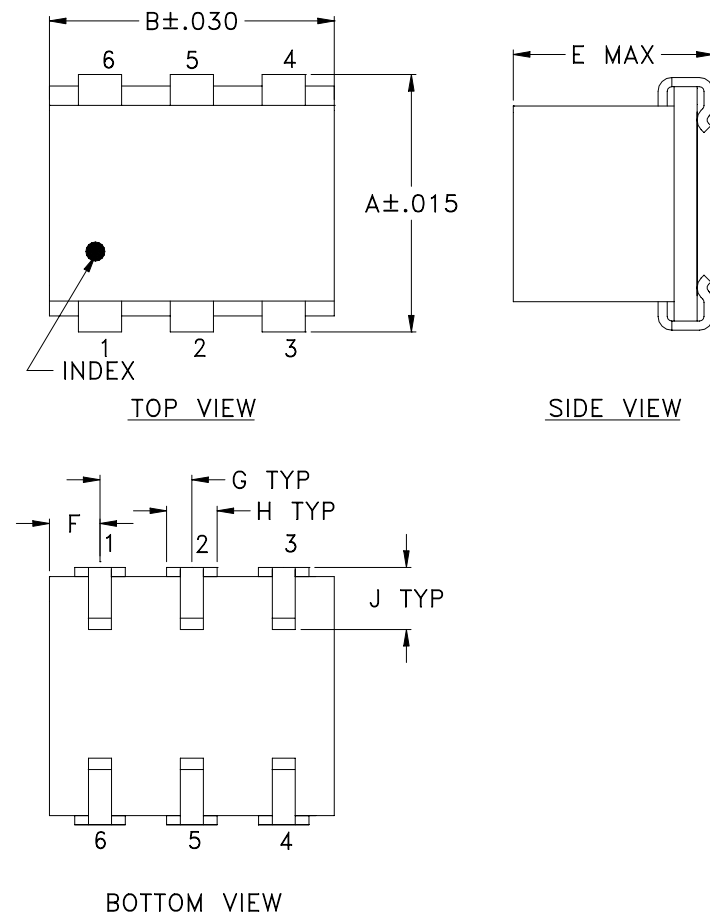
Insertion Loss



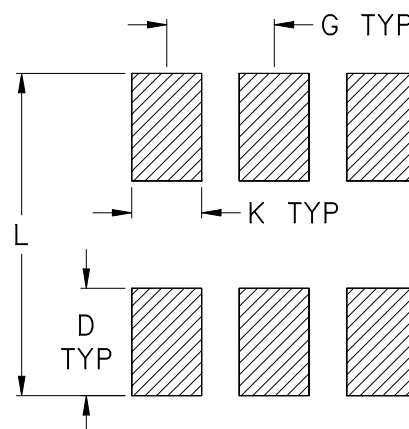
Return Loss

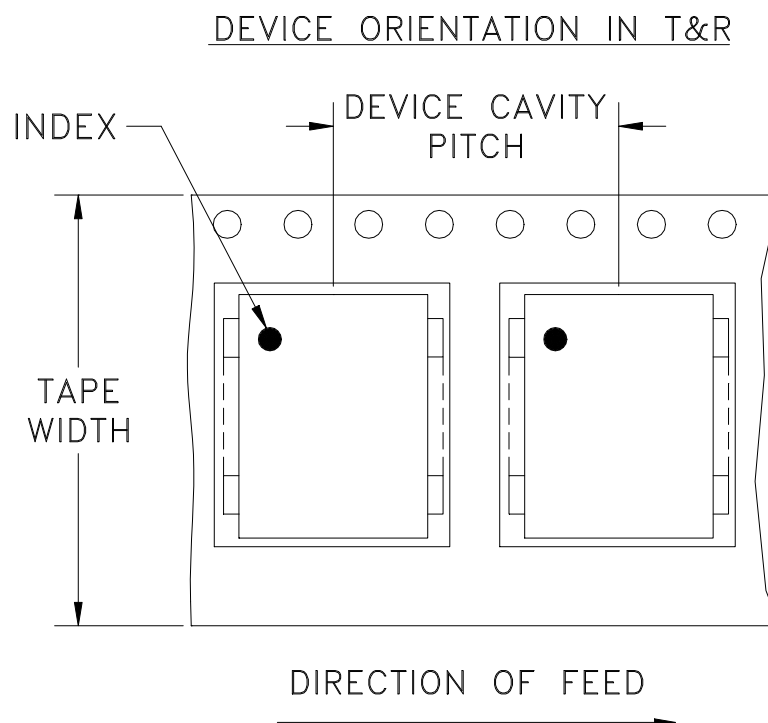
