SCHF-27+ is a 50Ω high pass filter fabricated using SMT technology. This SMT model offers lower insertion loss, good return loss, higher stopband rejection and a wider passband 27 to 1000 MHz. This filter is built with high Q capacitors and wire wound inductors for superior performance. It has repeatable performance across lots and consistent performance across temperature. The unit comes housed in a miniature plastic package measuring just 0.75 x 0.38 x 0.28", ideal for dense circuit board layouts.

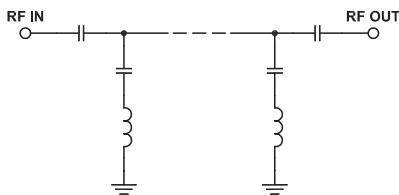

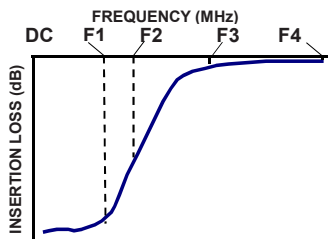

Typical Frequency Response

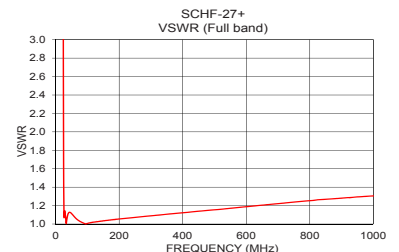
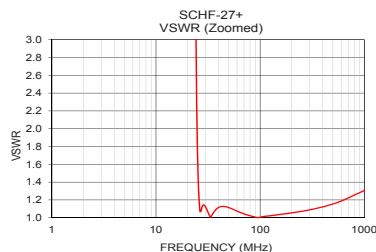
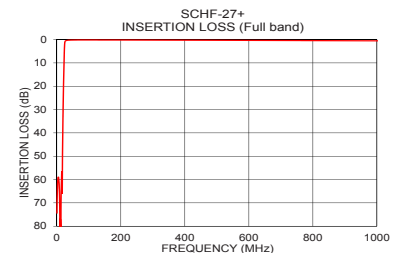
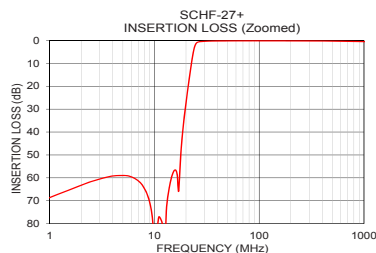

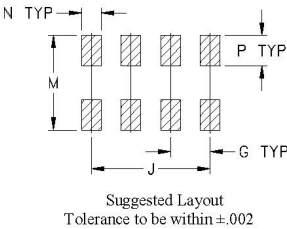

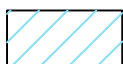

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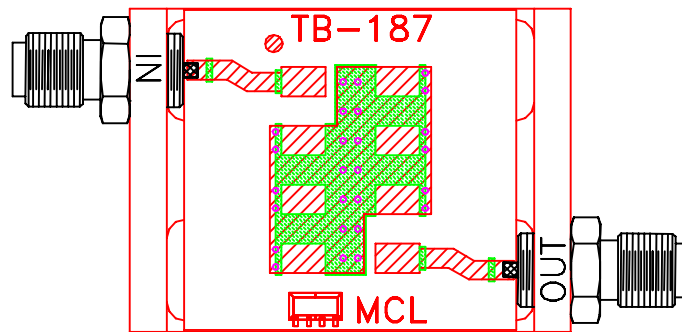

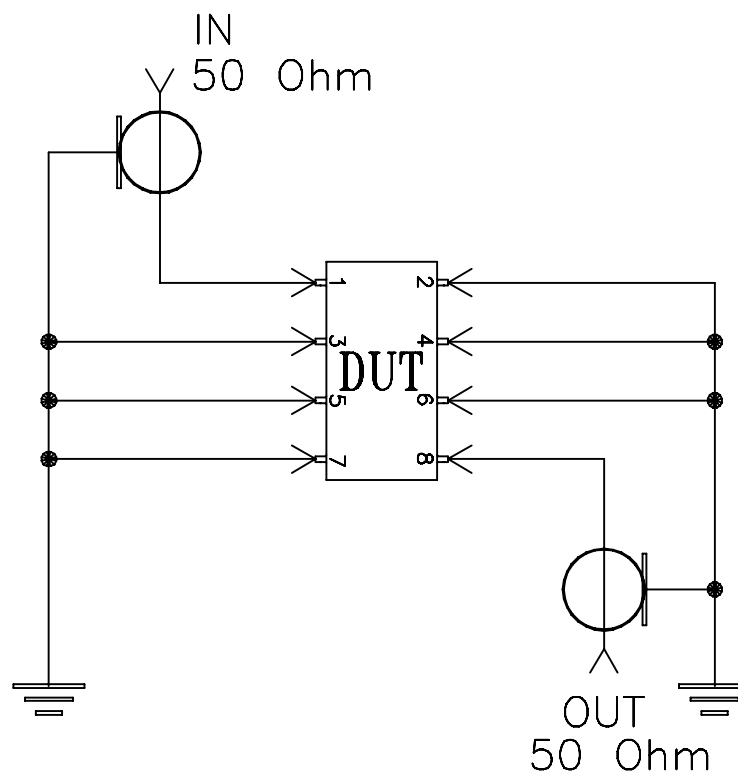
