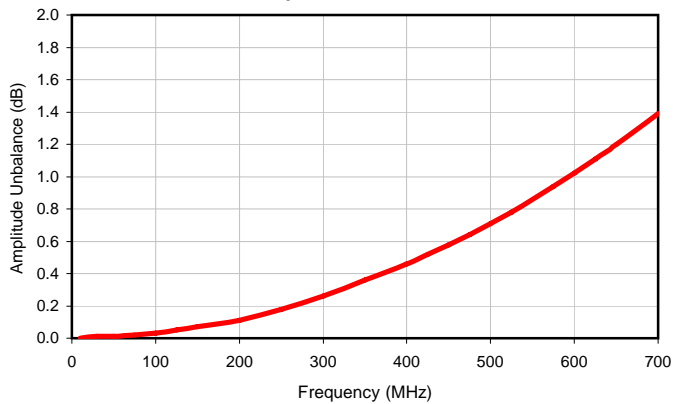
### Average Insertion Loss



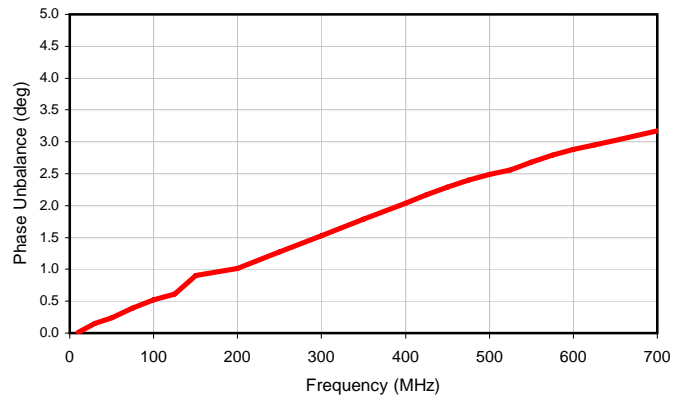
### Input Return Loss



### Amplitude Unbalance

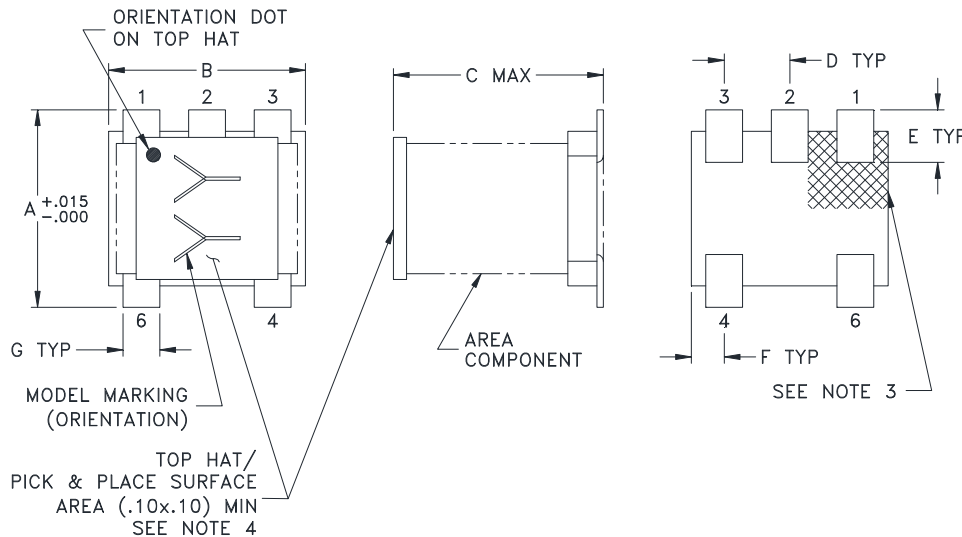


### Phase Unbalance

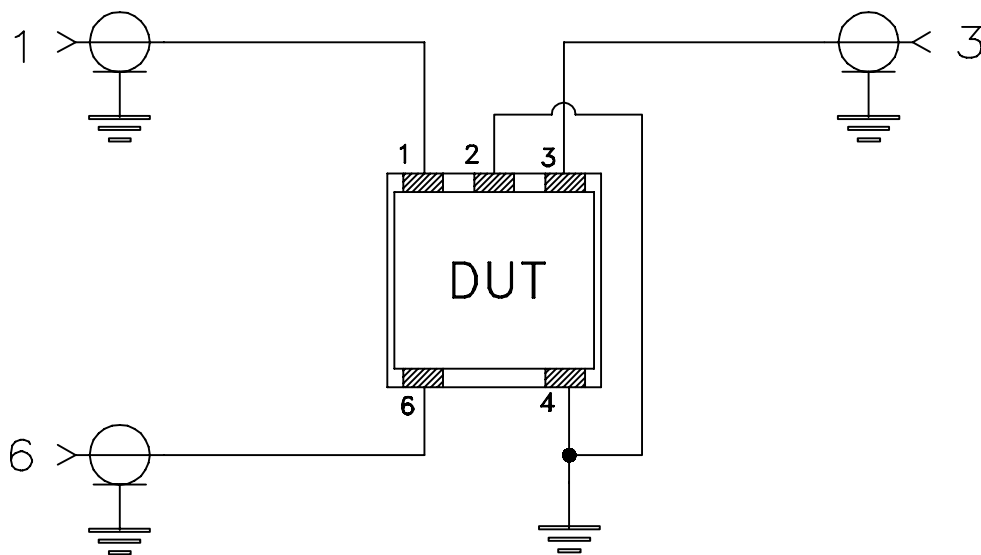
