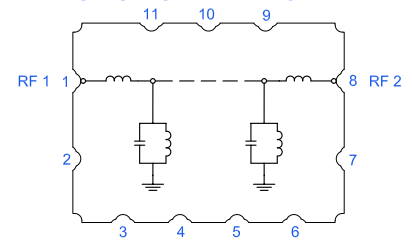

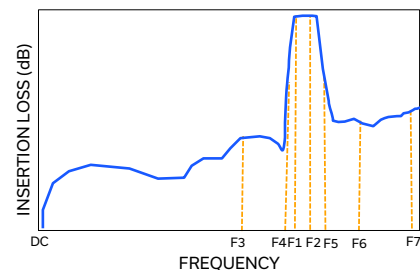

TYPICAL FREQUENCY RESPONSE



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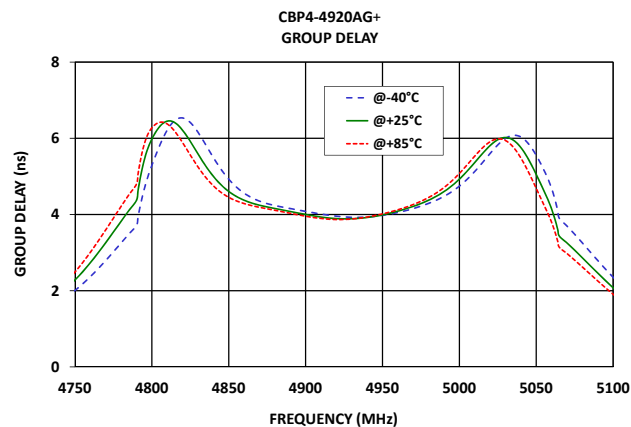
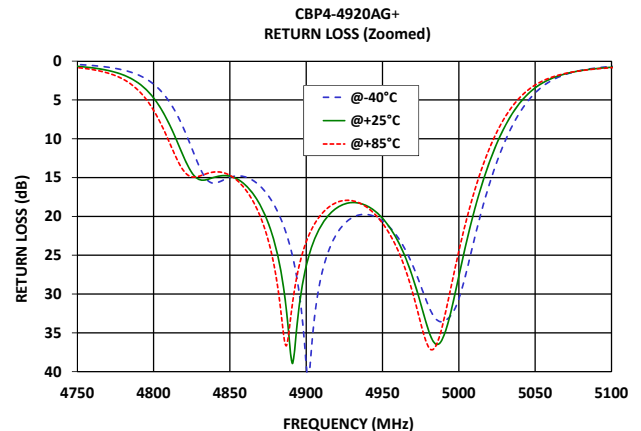
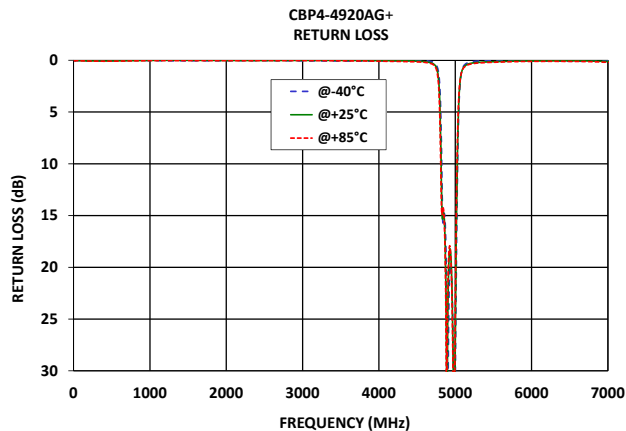
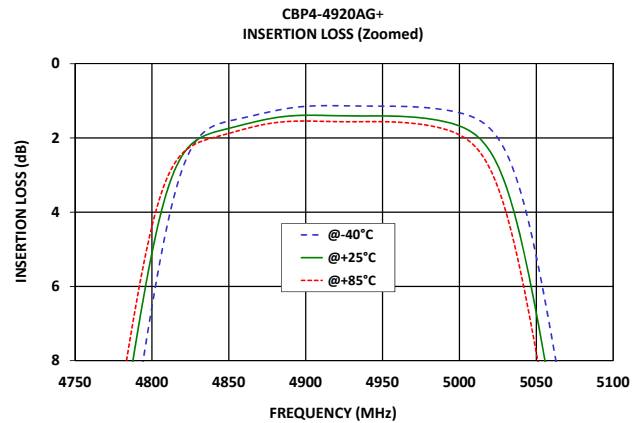
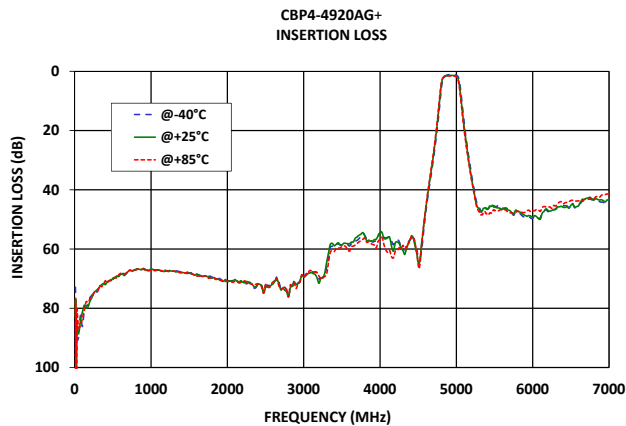

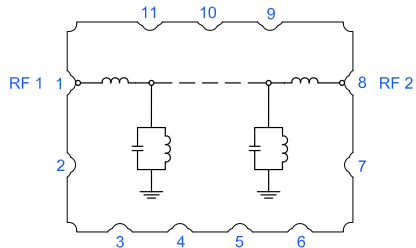
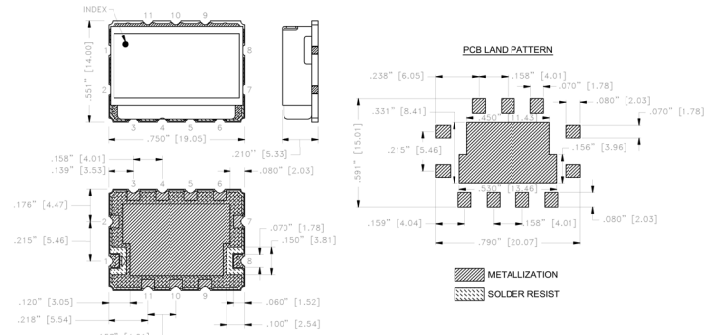


Figure 1. CBP4-4920AG+ Functional Diagram

GROUND	2-7,9,10,11	Connects to Ground on PCB, (See drawing PL-761)

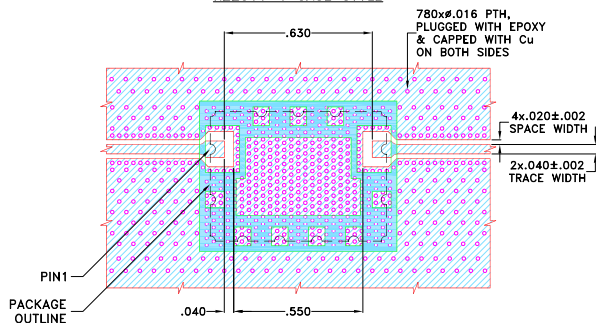
