

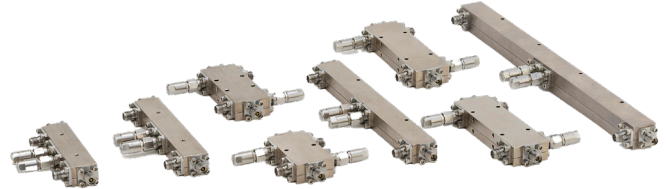

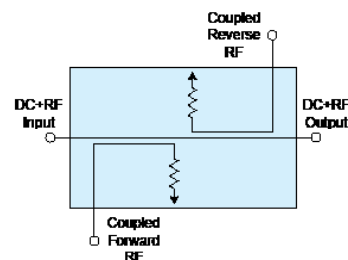

Electrical Schematic

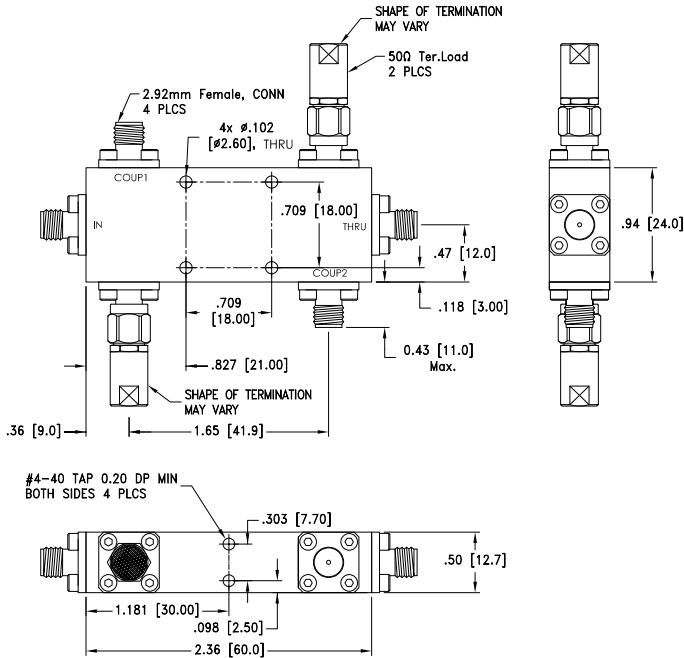


* Mainline is DC Coupled.

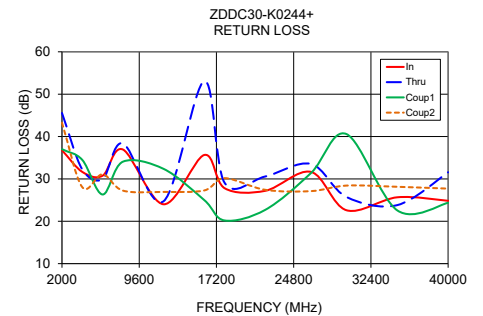
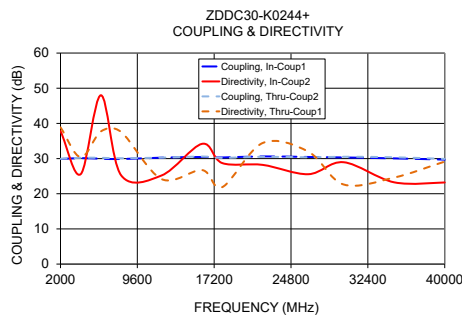
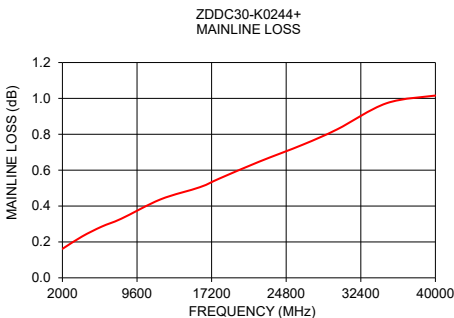
