Guidelines on how to interface with Programmable Logic Controllers

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1. Connectivity between the ISC-2425-25+ and a PLC system

The ISC-2425-25+ connects to any host computer through a USB virtual com port.

The USB virtual COM port is a software interface that enables applications to access a USB device as if it were a built-in serial port.

In this case the USB virtual COM-port device functions as bridge between USB and for example an RS-232 asynchronous serial interface.

Siemens S7:

To link a UART hardware to your S7 CPU 314C, all you need to do so is add a serial interface on your S7 PLC (and decide on the protocol and do some programming).
